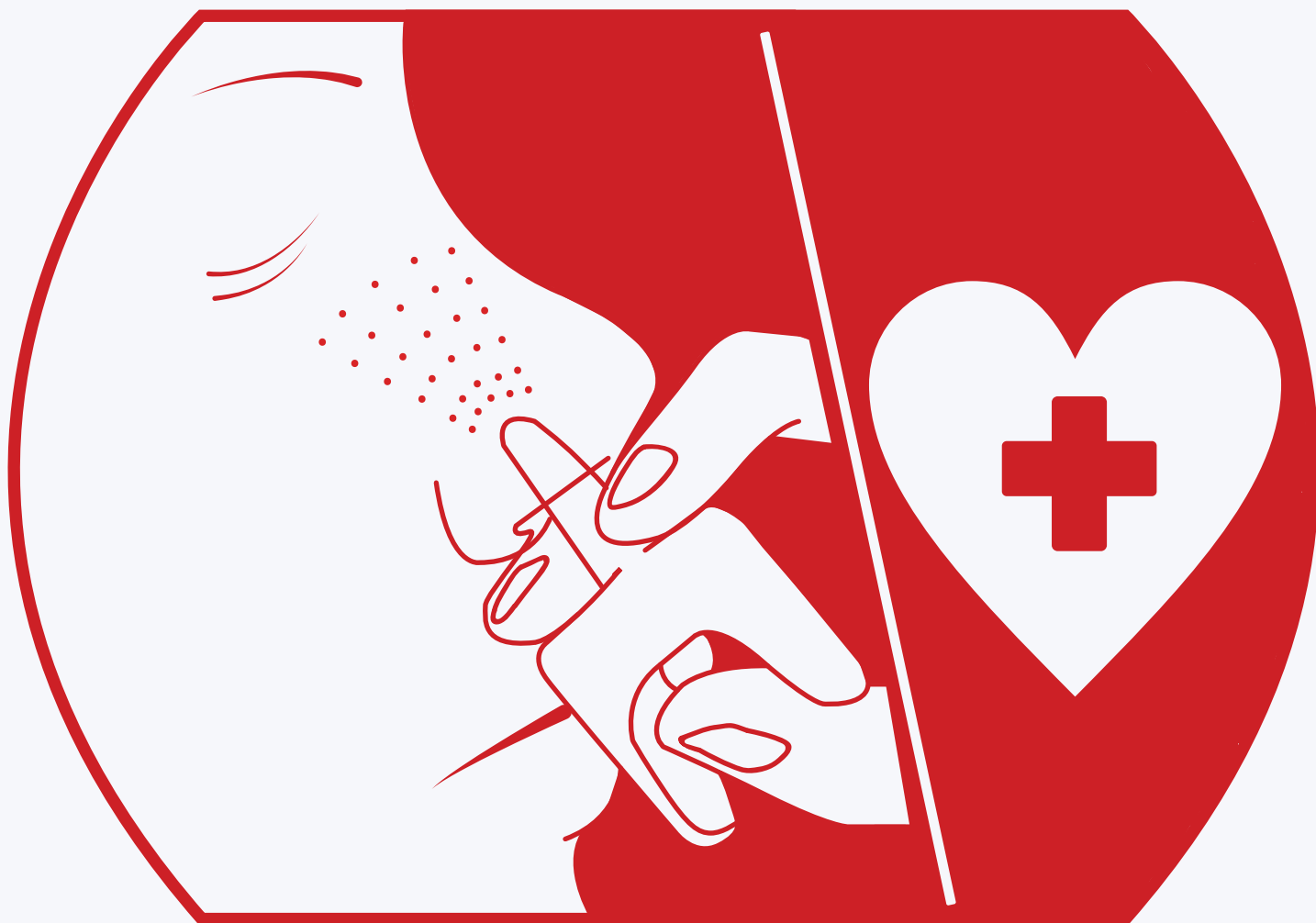


NALOXONE

opioid poisoning

how to respond and save a life

shake and shout

1



the person at their
shoulders

their name

2



call 911

if the person is unresponsive

3



spray naloxone

remove the naloxone from the kit and insert the tip into a nostril, then press the plunger firmly with your thumb

4



check breathing

if the person is **not** breathing, begin chest compressions and rescue breathing as trained or instructed by 911

5



is it working?

if **no** improvement after 3-5 minutes, repeat steps 3 and 4

if **yes**, stick around until EMS arrives in case the person still needs help



- Store naloxone at room temperature and away from light.
- Note its expiration date and contact Keeping Six at keepingsix.org/naloxone if you need a new kit.
